Examples of Large Numbers

One (1) – I have *one* nose.

Quintillion (1,000,000,000,000,000) – The Earth has **quintillions** of grains of sand on its beaches!

Sextillion (1,000,000,000,000,000,000) – The number of snowflakes that fall on Earth every winter is more than a **sextillion!**

Googol (1 followed by 100 zeros) – A **googol** is bigger than all the stars in the universe!
