

Comparison and Addition – Word Problems

1. Mary has 151 books. She has 43 books less than her brother. How many books do both of them have altogether?
2. Jake has 74 marbles. He has 13 more marbles than James. How many marbles do they have together?
3. Anna has 236 stickers. She has 58 stickers more than her sister. How many stickers do both girls have in total?
4. Tom has 120 toy cars. He has 35 fewer toy cars than his friend Ben. How many toy cars do Tom and Ben have altogether?
5. Lucy has 89 pencils. She has 17 pencils less than her cousin. How many pencils do they have together?

Comparison and Addition – Word Problems

6. Sam has 145 coins. He has 28 more coins than Alex. How many coins do Sam and Alex have in total?

7. Emma has 64 storybooks. She has 19 fewer storybooks than her brother. How many storybooks do they have altogether?

8. Noah has 210 trading cards. He has 45 more trading cards than Liam. How many trading cards do both boys have together?

9. Olivia has 98 beads. She has 26 beads less than her friend Mia. How many beads do they have in total?

10. Daniel has 375 stamps. He has 84 more stamps than his brother. How many stamps do they have together?

Comparison and Addition – Answer Key

1. The number of books Mary's brother has is $151 + 43 = 194$.
Mary and her brother have $151 + 194 = 345$ books altogether.
2. The number of marbles James has is $74 - 13 = 61$.
Jake and James have $74 + 61 = 135$ marbles together.
3. The number of stickers Anna's sister has is $236 - 58 = 178$.
Anna and her sister have $236 + 178 = 414$ stickers in total.
4. The number of toy cars Ben has is $120 + 35 = 155$.
Tom and Ben have $120 + 155 = 275$ toy cars altogether.
5. The number of pencils Lucy's cousin has is $89 + 17 = 106$.
Lucy and her cousin have $89 + 106 = 195$ pencils together.
6. The number of coins Alex has is $145 - 28 = 117$.
Sam and Alex have $145 + 117 = 262$ coins in total.
7. The number of storybooks Emma's brother has is $64 + 19 = 83$.
Emma and her brother have $64 + 83 = 147$ storybooks altogether.
8. The number of trading cards Liam has is $210 - 45 = 165$.
Noah and Liam have $210 + 165 = 375$ trading cards together.
9. The number of beads Mia has is $98 + 26 = 124$.
Olivia and Mia have $98 + 124 = 222$ beads in total.
10. The number of stamps Daniel's brother has is $375 - 84 = 291$.
Daniel and his brother have $375 + 291 = 666$ stamps altogether.
